GREETINGS unto Grom, Mighty Baron and Anneke, Wise Baroness, of Septentria;

While it saddens us that you will be vacating the Ursine thrones, we understand that this too is a part of the continuing cycle of growth for our Barony. We write to you this day to declare our intention to seek the throne of the people, that of the throne of Septentria - the heart of Ealdormere. We do not seek this honour lightly, having pondered long and well upon the significance of this honour, to us, and to the people of Septentria.

Sitting the High Seats of our Barony is a task that must be undertaken in a spirit of fun, but also with every intention of earnest effort, and tempered by the view that it is a serious endeavour. We feel that our traditions and our history must be honoured whilst promoting the changes necessary to achieve the growth required to

keep the Barony strong. Additionally, more needs be done to involve and engage all of the citizens of the Barony, especially the children, who are our future.

As to who we are, Seonag nic Thomais Bann Thegn, is a proud alumnus of the Iron Companions, holder of an Award of Arms, and 3 Bear's Claws; bearer of the Bear's Heart, the Maiden's Heart, and the Scarlet Banner, twice among the honored on the Ealdormerean Scroll of Honour, holder of a Grant of Arms, and former Baronial Champion by decree of your ancestors Cynred Broccan, Thegn and Baroness Gaerwen of Trafford for the Great Ursine Barony of Septentria.

Seonag is a fledgling bard and seeks to entertain those who would listen. She stood for nearly 3 years as the Editor of the Ursus-The voice of Septentria and was thrilled to be able to share the sights and sounds of the Barony through stories, pictures and editorials. For these efforts Seonag received two Blackfox Awards. She is a cook of some reknown, and a vintner, for a people cannot subsist on food for the soul alone.

Seonag has served as Royal Entourage, and stood as one of 12 of the Queen's Champion Guard to Genevieve de Chastelain D'Angou. She has planned and organized many demonstrations for the Canton of Caer Draeth and participated in many more to the aid of other groups within our fair land. As a cook, Seonag has been feast steward for many Kingdom and Baronial level events held within your land of Caer Draeth and more recently has provided a lunch counter for both Septentrian 12th Night and Fall Coronation. Seonag carries authorizations in all but one weapons form and offers her



services as a marshal-in-training for combat and a marshal for minor combat. She serves also in the capacity of water bearer and archer, and for three years, held the position of Ealdormere Commisar.

Streonwold Wulfesbana, Thegn, is Squired to Sir Berus Wolfsonne of House Hrogn, is a former member of the Isengesitha, holder of an Award of Arms, bearer of 5 Bears Claws, the Bear's Heart, the Maiden's Heart, the Orion and the Scarlet Banner, honoured on Ealdormere's Scroll of Honour, holds a Grant of Arms, and is a companion of the Order of Thorbjorn's Hammer.

Streonwold has stood as King's Champion during the reign of Sir Malik ab al Raman and Mistress Genevieve de Chastelain D'Angou. He is also well versed in service and the arts. He is a teacher, musician, cook, ironsmith, leather worker, vintner and herald. Many a hall has rung with his voice as Court Herald for many kings and queens and many have heeded his words. He holds authorizations in all forms of chivalric combat, serves as marshal, and is a proud member of the White Bear Fian. Streonwold also is a cook of no small repute and his work in iron, leather, mead and more have been seen as entries in the Kingdom Arts and Sciences competition.

Both of us have held officer's positions in the past and continue to do so. Streonwold has stood as Canton Seneschal, Knight's Marshal, Chronicler, and Pursuivant for the Canton of Caer Draeth. He currently stands as Baronial Marshal for the Barony. Seonag has stood as Seneschal, Chatelaine, Chronicler, Pursuivant, and Quarter Master and continues to stand as Canton Regalia officer for Caer Draeth. She also currently holds

the position of Canton Exchequer, a position she will relinquish to a chosen deputy should our bid for the Baronacy prove successful.

We know well the needs for organization and communication. Mundanely we bring these skills as well. For many years we both taught first aid for the Canadian Ski Patrol system. We also offered our services as CPR instructors for the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario where Seonag was a course director for several courses offered to the Canadian Ski Patrol system. Streonwold has been a Patrol Leader and Director of Nordic Training. These roles allowed us to gain skill as teachers, first aiders, and to expand on our organizational abilities.

Seonag's job is with Environment Canada as a procurement support officer after 22 years as a lab supervisor. The requirements of report writing, presentation of scientific papers, organizing and running multiple projects, training and supervising students, computer skills and interaction with various local, national and international groups will all prove useful skills in helping run the Barony from a "business" stance. In her procurement role, Seonag is responsible for providing timely informa-

tion on acquisitions as well as being able to provide guidance on the rules and regulations of government acquisitions.

Streonwold also brings similar skills to the table as a former line manager for Bombardier Aerospace, a local aircraft manufacturer. As manager for over 10 years he gained first hand knowledge of the importance of organization, motivation, good communication, and diplomacy as well as the need to "multi task" effectively within strict time constraints.

We have been with the Society of Creative Anachronism and as members in good standing for almost 20 years, and we believe that we have much to offer the Barony, her people and the Kingdom. If it is the will of the people, and with your blessing, we would request that we be considered for this honour.

BARONIAL SUCCESSION POLICY

Barony of Septentria, Kingdom of Ealdormere, SCA Inc. Succession Policy & Procedures – revised *****.

The election will be coordinated by the baronial seneschal, and overseen by the kingdom seneschal, with the ability to coordinate the election personally if they deem it necessary.

I. Qualifications for the Baronial Seat.

Any individual wishing to be considered for the honour of the Baron and/or Baroness of Septentria must:

- A. Be acceptable to the crown.
- B. Be an international or family member in good standing of the SCA Inc..
- C. Be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- D. Be a resident of or an active participant in the Barony of Septentria for a minimum of three years before the date of his/her selection to the honour of the Baronial seat (s).
- E. All candidates must meet the requirements as set out by Corpora and Kingdom Law.

Candidates may be an individual or a couple of any gender.

II. Participation of the Barony's Populace: Populace Poll

Members of the Barony shall have the opportunity to express to the Crown their consensus as to the choice of the Baron/ness in the form of a written poll. These written poll results shall be provided to the Crown to assist the Crown in the confirmation of Baron/ness but shall not bind the Crown in any manner whatsoever.

Only paid members of the SCA, over the age of 16 and residing in the Barony of Septentria are eligible to cast a ballot. The ballot will include a list of all approved candidates to be placed in rank of preference (1st, 2nd 3rd etc...)

Voting shall occur pursuant to Voting Process (Schedule "A")

Unpaid members of the barony will be polled separately to be considered.

Proxy votes will be accepted pursuant to the proxy vote procedure outlined as part of the Voting process (Schedule "A").

Definition of a member of the Barony of Septentria - Someone who lives within the boundaries of Septentria, who does not have a strong affiliation with another Barony. Or a member of the Barony can be someone living outside the boarders of Septentria who is active within the Barony and considers themselves a member of the Barony.

III. Candidates for the Baronial Seat(s)

Anyone wishing to run for the Baronial Seats must meet the requirements listed above.

A letter of intent must be given to the present Baron and Baroness and the Baronial Seneschal within the announced time frame.

With the letter of intent the potential candidate(s) must include a copy of their memberships.

IV. Order of events

Approximately 6 months before the Baron and Baroness intend to retire the current Baron and Baroness shall announce their intent to retire in a court. This shall initiate the process.

Notification shall be posted in the next issue of The Ursus, The Baronial newsletter or in a special additional Baronial newsletter; stipulating that they will step down and those copies of the letters of intent from the Candidates will be accepted by Their Excellencies and the Baronial Seneschal. At the same time the Baronial Succession Policy shall be published. This information shall also be made available at all meetings, practices, workshops, local events and on the Baronial newsgroup, or by e-mail to anyone who should wish a copy.

At the application deadline, the list of prospective candidates will be sent to the Crown (present and Heirs) and the Kingdom Seneschal for approval.

Upon return and approval from the Royals and the Seneschal, the list shall be finalized and the successful Candidates will be notified.

From time of notification of the candidates, over the next several weeks as outlined by the schedule, will have the opportunity to attend at least one scheduled candidate meeting were the populous can ask them questions.

The Baronial Seneschal will prepare the ballots and the non member polling according to corpora and Kingdom law.

Voting will occur as outlined in the time lines published.

The voting process will take no longer then 30 days.

The Baronial Seneschal, the Baron and Baroness and an agreed upon Kingdom representative shall do a final tally the votes. If any of the aforementioned parties are unavailable for counting the votes on the scheduled date, then they shall appoint a deputy who can fulfill these duties. If the Baronial Seneschal and or the sitting Baron and Baroness are running in the election, then the Kingdom Seneschal shall appoint someone to oversee the final tally of the votes.

Should the Candidate(s) meet with the Crown's approval, then the current Baron and Baroness will step down at an event chosen by the crown, the new Baron and/or Baroness will be invested by the Crown of Ealdormere at their pleasure and in accordance with Kingdom and Society laws.

This version of the Baronial Succession Policy for the Barony of Septentria supersedes all previous revisions.

SCHEDULE "A"

Baronial Voting Process

Voting will take place in each Canton between Feb 14th and March 1st 2015

On Voting Day, the Baronial Seneschal or designate will attend the Canton Meeting to administer the vote.

The Baronial Seneschal, Canton Seneschal and Canton Exchequer (or designate) will be required for counting the ballots at the end of the night.

A designated area will be set aside at the meeting for filling out the ballots in private.

A listing of paid members for the Barony will be used to 'check in' voters. Those not on the list will be added separately. Either the Baronial or Canton Seneschal (or designate) will oversee the check in. **Attendees MUST show their proof of membership**. At this time voters will be given either a Blue Ballot (Paid Members) or a White Ballot (Non paid Members), and directed to the designated voting area.

Voters will assign a number (1 being most preferred, to 4 being least preferred) to each of the Candidates listed on the ballots. The ballot is then placed in the ballot box.

Note that the ballots are anonymous and do not connect the voters on the check in sheet to the ballot.

Once all voters have cast their ballot, the Baronial Seneschal, Canton Seneschal and Canton Exchequer (or designate) will take the ballot box and retire to a private area to begin counting the ballots. Each will do a count of all ballots and complete a tally sheet (provided), and sign off on their count.

The ballots will be placed in a sealed envelope and signed by the three Officers.

These envelopes will be kept secure by the Baronial Seneschal until all voting is completed in the Barony. Once complete, the Baronial Seneschal & Baronial Pursuivant will tally all votes and provide a summary report of each canton and the full Barony to Their Majesties, and Their Excellencies.

Proxy Voting Process


If a voter is unable to attend the voting meeting, they may cast a Proxy Vote via the following procedure:

You may send your vote with another person to the voting meeting to cast a ballot. That person **MUST** have a letter from you that includes the following:

- Your Full Real Name
- Your Sca Name
- Your Mailing Address in full
- Your Membership # (or indicate Non Member)
- Your membership Expiry Date
- · Canton you reside in
- · Permission for the person (specifically named) to cast your vote
- · Your vote on all final candidates
- Your signature and date

The voter MUST inform the Baronial Seneschal prior to the vote date that they intend to authorize someone to vote on their behalf.

Proxies that do not have all the required information; or are not submitted by the end of the business meeting at which the vote is being taken will be invalidated. The letter once brought to the meeting and submitted to the Baronial Seneschal will become the persons ballot and kept separate from the ballots (to ensure anonymity) For counting purposes, a ballot will be prepared by the Baronial Seneschal and added to the others, witnessed by the Canton Seneschal.
